What We Do

Maple Leaf is a non-profit corporation. Our primary goal is to purchase or rent homes to provide residences for people referred to us by the GCBMR/DD, Metzenbaum Center. Our responsibilities include their maintenance, with an emphasis on health and safety, and as required architectural improvements to provide more efficient use for people with particular disabilities.

Most of our homes are four or five bedroom units with at least two bathrooms. We currently have fourteen residences providing homes for four people each; we also have one condominium with three residents and one home with one resident.

One of our goals is to increase the number of homes available to our future residents.
